

## **Tenth Pastoral Letter to the Wesley Church Family on current Covid-19 situation (08 October 2021)**

**Dear Wesleyans,**

May God's peace guard your hearts in our Lord Jesus in this challenging and uncertain season. I pray for God's grace and strength to be with you as we persevere together through these challenging times.

We are aware of a recent Straits Times report on 4 Oct 2021 about a grandmother who has been hospitalised because of taking ivermectin. This happened because friends in her church had urged her not to get vaccinated with particular vaccines as they held the view that these were against God.

While we should respect the strong convictions of some not to be vaccinated, or who have preferences for certain vaccines, we also strongly urge against any reliance on hearsay/unproven remedies. Let us also be mindful not to spread unproven theories. Please seek medical advice before administering any form of unapproved medical self-protection against Covid-19. For example, ivermectin is a prescription-only drug not approved by Health Sciences Authority for use in the prevention or treatment of Covid-19. Unauthorised sale and distribution of such medicine is illegal.
